Dear Customer,

Thank you for your questions regarding Clorox® Professional Products surface disinfectant products and the Ebola virus.

There is currently an Ebola virus outbreak affecting multiple countries in West Africa. Additionally, [the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\) confirmed the first Ebola case diagnosed in the United States](#). CDC recognizes that even a single case of Ebola diagnosed in the United States raises concerns. CDC has been working with medical and public health professionals across the United States to prepare and respond to any potential Ebola cases.

Ebola virus causes viral hemorrhagic fever disease, a severe, often fatal disease in humans. Ebola virus is transmitted through direct contact with the blood and body fluids of an infected symptomatic person or through exposure to objects (such as needles) that have been contaminated with infected blood or body fluids.

Currently, the Ebola virus is not available for efficacy testing in the United States. There are no surface disinfectant products EPA-registered to kill the Ebola virus. This includes both manual disinfectants and ultra violet (UV) technologies.

Healthcare workers are advised to follow CDC's [infection control recommendations](#) to use isolation and infection control procedures including standard, contact, and droplet precautions to safely manage hospitalized patients with known or suspected Ebola hemorrhagic fever.

[CDC recommends](#) the use of EPA registered hospital disinfectants with label claims for non-enveloped viruses to disinfect environmental surfaces in rooms housing patients with known or suspected Ebola virus infection.
